

# WEEKEND CAMPOUT EQUIPMENT LIST

## MUST BRING:

A pack or backpack  
A sleeping bag or bed roll  
A tent  
A poncho or rain gear  
A 1 qt. canteen or water bottle (full)  
A pocketknife (folding type)  
A compass  
A mug or cup with a handle  
A plastic groundsheet (5'x10')  
A reliable flashlight (with new batteries)

### Clothes to suit the weather

Jacket, gloves, hat, etc.  
Extra shirt, pants, underwear \*\*  
Extra socks (2-3 pair)\*\*  
Boots (water repellent)

### Sleepwear to suit the weather\*\*

### Personal toiletries

Soap in plastic container  
Comb or Brush

Toothbrush & toothpaste  
Washcloth & Hand towel\*\*  
Part of a roll of toilet paper  
Small Personal First Aid Kit

## MIGHT WANT TO BRING:

A small pillow  
2' by 2' plastic sheet to sit on  
A Mess kit with knife/fork/spoon  
A watch  
An air mattress or foam pad  
A small folding camp stool  
Bug repellent (non-aerosol)  
Sun screen (non-aerosol)  
Sunglasses  
Your Boy Scout Handbook  
5-6 sheets of notepaper  
A pen or pencil  
Chapstick  
A whistle (in case you wander away & get lost)  
Binoculars  
Camera

## MUST NOT BRING:

Axes or hatchets  
Fixed blade knives  
Electronic games  
Magazines  
Comic Books

- any other things you know you should not bring.

## **\*\*ADDITIONAL ITEMS NEEDED FOR MORE THAN ONE NIGHT OF CAMPING:**

- Wear your complete scout uniform while traveling to/from the campsite.
- Put all non-water repellent things in separate zip lock bags.
- Sleeping bag or bedroll should be in waterproof bag.
- Do not put candy, nuts food or anything sweet smelling in your pack.
- Pack securely so that you can carry it all at once.
- Totin' Chip required, to have or use a knife.
- All medicines (prescriptions & over-the-counter) **must** be brought to the Scoutmaster's attention.
